Being a By-law to Authorize Entering Into An
Engineering Agreement With Spriet Associated Architects & Engineers
For The Bearss Municipal Drain

Whereas on September 15, 1997, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacted Bylaw 3429/11/97, being a By-law to provide for drainage works in the City of Port Colborne in the Regional Municipality of Niagara Bearss Drain and William Michael Drain; and

Whereas by resolution on April 23, 2024, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne approved the appointment of Brandon Widner, P. Eng of Spriet Associates Engineers & Architects to proceed with the preparation of a new engineer's report to address the watershed limit of the Bearss Municipal Drain and revise the assessment schedules of the report; and

Whereas it is deemed expedient that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne appoint an engineer to prepare a report that address the watershed limit of the Bearss Municipal Drain and revise the assessment schedules of the report;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Port Colborne under the *Drainage Act R.S.O. 1990*, enacts as follows:

1. That The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enter into an Engineering Agreement with Spriet Associates Engineers & Architects regarding the Bearss Drain for the provision of drainage works.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute an Engineering Agreement, in a form satisfactory to the Director of Public Works, and the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
