What are Ontario Health Teams (OHTs)? Why are they here?

How health care looks now

Presently, a patient relates separately with organizations and providers within the health system.



How health care will look with OHTs

An OHT is one entity made up of a number of organizations and providers. A patient will receive health care that is coordinated within an OHT.





When did it start and what do OHTs do?

- Ontario Health Teams (OHTs) were introduced by the Government of Ontario in 2019
- OHTs provide a new way of organizing and delivering care that is more connected to patients/clients in their communities





NOHT-ÉSON

What is the Niagara Ontario Health Team - Équipe Santé Ontario Niagara?

- The NOHT-ÉSON is a network of 45+ health care providers, social service agencies, educational institutions and patient/client and family/caregiver representatives
- NOHT-ÉSON partners provide a wide array of services—primary care, home care, emergency services, public health, social services, mental health and addictions, long-term care, rehabilitation, and acute care

The overarching governing body that sets the strategic direction of the OHT.

Working Groups

Approximately 17 various working groups, project teams, and task forces (e.g. dementia care, cancer screening, palliative care, alternate level of care, mental health and addictions).

Consensus Decision-Making

All voices have equal weight. No voting.
