Act, R	Now therefore, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 34 of the <i>Planning S.O. 1990</i> , The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts as follows:
	This amendment shall apply to those lands described on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law.
	That the Zoning Map referenced as Schedule "A7" forming part of By-law 6575/30/18 is hereby amended by changing those lands described on Schedule A to Second Density Residential (R2).
3.	That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day that it is passed by Council, subject to the provisions of the <i>Planning Act</i> .
	The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the giving notice of the passing of this by-law, in accordance with the <i>Planning Act</i> .
