Whereas Council is desirous of providing for the appointment of a Chief Building Official, a Deputy Chief Building Official and Building Inspectors; and	
ena	Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne acts as follows:
1.	That Gerald Moore be appointed as Chief Building Official for The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne.
2.	That Devon Staley be appointed as Deputy Chief Building Official for The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne
3.	That the duties of the Chief Building Official will be those set out in the <i>Building Code Act 1992</i> , <i>S.O. 1992</i> , <i>c. 23</i> and the Regulations thereunder, the Corporation's zoning and building by-laws and such other duties as Council may impose from time to time.
4.	That Barbara Mocny, Mike McKean, John Drahorat and Grant Schwartzentruber be appointed as Building Inspectors for the City of Port Colborne.
5.	That these appointments shall come into force and effect as of May 31st, 2022, and shall remain in effect until such appointments are rescinded or successors are appointed.
6.	That By-law 6980/18/22 be repealed.
