Discussion:

Committees and boards provide advice, guidance, and support to Council as they consider matters such as environmental, heritage, and other local matters.

Committees are comprised of lay members of the public, Council, and various other stakeholder representatives.

Some of the responsibilities of the Council representative on committees include:

- Ensure the committee members are appropriately engaged on the committee mandate and workplan;
- Liaise between Council and the committee and assist in providing information and clarification;

- Update the committee members on Council issues that may affect the goals and objectives of the committee;
- When necessary and appropriate, explain the rationale behind the committee's recommendation to Council when brought forward to Council.

Council appointments to committees are made on the basis of interest and the requirements of the Committees, while meeting the needs of the community and striving for a balance in workload requirements. Staff recommend a Council Member Appointment to Committee Policy be drafted to ensure the appointment process is provided to be fair, consistent, and transparent.

The Clerk has sought and subsequently received each Councillor's preference as it relates to those boards/committees they would prefer to represent. The list of Boards and Committees requiring Council representatives is based on recommendations included in Staff Report 2022-264.

Financial Implications:

There are no financial implications associated with this report. Any remuneration provided to committee members is budgeted for in the 2023 operating budget.
