By-law No
Being a By-law to Authorize the Dedication of Part 4 Plan 59R-17452 as a Public Highway
Whereas at its meeting of February 28th, 2023, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne (Council) approved the recommendations of Chief Administrative Officer Report 2023-25, Subject: Dedicate a portion of Borden Avenue as a Public Highway, Part 4, Plan 59R-17542; and
Whereas Section 27(1) of the <i>Municipal Act</i> , 2001, provides that, except as otherwise provided in the Act, a municipality may pass by-laws in respect of a highway only if it has jurisdiction over the highway; and
Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts as follows:
That a portion of the Borden Avenue Road Allowance, legally described as Part 4, Plan 59R-17542, be dedicated as a public highway;
That the Mayor, the Acting City Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any documents that may be required for the purpose of carrying out the intent of this bylaw and the Acting City Clerk is dully authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
That the City Solicitor be and is hereby directed to prepare and register all such documents in the proper Land Registry Office to dedicate a portion of Borden Avenue Road Allowance as a public highway.
This by-law shall take effect on the day that a certified copy of the by-law is registered in the proper land registry office.
