Being a By-law to Authorize Entering into an Indenture with the Regional Municipality of Niagara to transfer ownership of the watermains on Pine Street and Highland Avenue
Whereas at its meeting of April 11, 2023, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne ("Council") approved the recommendations of Public Works Report 2023-68, Subject: Transfer of Ownership of Pine Street and Highland Avenue Watermains, and
Whereas Council is desirous of entering into an indenture agreement with the Niagara Region; and
Whereas the <i>Municipal Act</i> , 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, confers broad authority on municipalities to enter into such agreements;
Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts as follows:
 That the Corporation of the City of Port Colborne execute the indenture agreement to assume ownership of the Pine Street and Highland Avenue watermains from the Regional Municipality of Niagara;

That the Mayor and the Acting City Clerk be and are hereby authorized and directed to sign the said agreement, attached hereto as Schedule "A", together with any documents necessary to complete the conditions of the said agreement, and the Acting City Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
