Whereas the City of Port Colborne has adopted By-law No. 6902/50/21
Being a By-law to Establish a System for Administrative Penalties for Non-
Parking Offences within the City of Port Colborne; and

Whereas at its meeting of June 13, 2023, the Council of The Corporation of
the City of Port Colborne approved the recommendations of the
Community Safety and Enforcement Department, By-law Services Report
2023-111 Subject: Administrative Monetary Tier Penalty – Cat By-law; and

Whereas The City of Port Colborne considers it desirable to add the
Control of Cats to the Administrative Monetary Penalty, tier penalty system;
and

Whereas the City of Port Colborne considers it desirable and necessary to
amend By-law No. 6902/50/21 Being a By-law to Establish a System for
Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Offences within the City of Port
Colborne;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne
enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "B" is hereby amended to include administrative
penalties for the Control of Cats By-law No. 4949/5/07, as
amended.
2. That Schedule "B" is hereby amended to include tier penalty system.
